Denver Waives Youth Rec Center Fees for Summer

Mayor John Hickenlooper, members of City Council and Denver Parks and Recreation Acting Manager Scott Robson have announced that Denver youth age 17 and younger may use City recreation centers, including swimming pools, for free this summer.

Free admission begins Monday, June 2 - the day City swimming pools open - and will run through Saturday, August 16. Standard fees will continue to apply for programs and activities that typically are offered at an additional charge.

Area recreation centers offer a variety of summer activities, including open swim, basketball, game room and a Food Bank of the Rockies program that offers free food for families. Programs available for a nominal fee include Hoopin' with Hickenlooper, baseball, t-ball, volleyball and swim lessons.
