Thank you for the application you recently filed for a **Beer and Wine Liquor License at 3422 E. 12th Avenue, Denver, Colorado**. You are notified to appear in this office for a public hearing on this application on **Thursday February 22, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.**

Enclosed herewith for the applicant is a copy of the findings rendered in this matter. Please be advised that you are required to appear at the Department of Excise & Licenses for a **pre-hearing conference on Wednesday January 13, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.** At this conference, you will be required to submit all of the requirements set forth in the attached findings. Failure to submit these requirements may result in a cancellation of the above set public hearing date and a need for you to resubmit a new application and application fees. Please do not hesitate to contact this office at (720)865-2760 should you have any questions regarding the findings.

At that time of the public hearing on **February 22nd**, you will be required to prove why said application should be approved. You will be required to present evidence demonstrating the neighborhood need and that the residents and/or business owners or managers in the area around your location desire that the license issue even if the application is not contested. You must also establish that the issuance of this license will not have an adverse effect on the health, welfare or morals of the neighborhood in question. The Department of Excise and Licenses has designated an area around your location on a map. You must present up to three adult witnesses who are residents or business owners/managers from the designated area to testify as a group in support of the application.

A manager must have general supervisory authority over the business. The protestor to the application, if there are any, will also be allowed to present up to three witnesses to testify individually and others to testify as a group. Representatives from any registered neighborhood organizations in the area will also be allowed to testify regarding the organization's position.

In addition, you may present petitions that have been signed by residents or business owners/managers in the designated area in support of the application. Petitions that are filed five days prior to the hearing at the Department of Excise and Licenses and accompanied by completed affidavits furnished by the Department will be admitted without testimony. Petitions not filed in this manner will be admitted only through the testimony of the circulators in person at the hearing. The same restrictions apply to protestors petitions.

Publication of notice of this application will occur on **January 20, 2010** and will be provided by the Department of Excise and Licenses. Posting of the premises shall also commence on **January 20, 2010**


and continue through the date of your hearing. **Petitions** may be circulated beginning **January 22, 2010**. Signatures obtained prior to this date will not be accepted.

Please be advised that if you are not prepared to proceed with the hearing on **February 22, 2010**, you may be required to reapply with new application forms and the payment of another application fee and re-posting of the premises.


